Child Care and Development

SNEHA has been implementing the child care and development project since last 24 years with the continuous support of CTW, Germany. We established the children's homes for the children who are not in reach of the education. These includes semi-orphans and poorest of the poor. We are providing food, shelter, education, health, transportation clothes and sanitary items for all the home children. We are also providing after-school education and trainings.

During the year 2024-25 there are around 434 children supported by CTW, Germany. Among these, there are 291 Girls and 143 boys. We are providing residential care for 440 children and Extended Foster ship Grant to 149 children. Children from 2nd class to professional courses are benefitted from CTW support.

These 8 homes are located in different places. Each home is being taken care by a warden and three other required staff members. All these children are studying in Government schools and colleges. Very few are studying in private colleges.

Prevention of HIV/AIDS

NACO extended its support to SNEHA through APSACS to implement the preventive activities of HIV/AIDS for the migrant communities. This is an ongoing activity since 2008.

SNEHA is implementing prevention of HIV/AIDS activities among the migrant population in seven mandals of N.T.R. District. The target for the coming 1 year is also for 10000 migrants. DAPCU and District medical and Health department is providing guidance and necessary support in implementation of the planned activities. Main activities of the programme is conducting medical camps ,CBS (Community based screening) tests to detect the cases, organizing events and demonstration events, blood donation camps, establishment and maintenance of 48 hot spots in different places. Condom promotion is through these hot spots and also local medical shops.

We are concentrating on the follow-up activities for the identified HRGs at the field level. BCC activity and other planned activities are successfully implemented. Number of ICTC checkups was regular and increasing according to the cases traced. It is observed that the people are prepared to use social marketing condoms.
